



Declaration of Conformity for California Proposition 65

Kingston Technology International, Ltd. (“Kingston”) understands and complies with the obligations under the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, commonly known as Proposition 65 (“Prop 65”). This regulation aims to protect California’s drinking water sources and requires businesses to provide warnings when their products expose individuals to chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

Kingston has conducted a review of its memory products and determined that, under normal and intended use, the anticipated exposure levels do not pose a significant risk of cancer and do not exceed the safe harbor levels for reproductive toxicity, as defined under Proposition 65.

To support this assessment, Kingston evaluates supplier declarations, materials content reports, and confidential chemical composition data. Based on the best available information and to the best of our knowledge and belief, certain products may contain one or more substances listed under Proposition 65. However, these chemicals are not intended to be released or result in exposure during typical product use.

If it is determined—based on current material data or risk assessments—that a Prop 65 warning is necessary, Kingston will ensure the provision of a “clear and reasonable” warning as required by the regulation.
